I again strongly object to this development for the following reasons: Lingards road is already dangerous due to lack of footpaths complemented by blind corners on a single lane eroded track with limited passing points. The transport statement does not reflect any of these points and has not been put together in a competent manner. Slaithwaite village is hugely overcrowded with traffic as it is, carbon footprint and noise / air pollution will only be increased. The local doctors surgeries are struggling to cope with increased demand, there are no dentists at all and the schools are full. The design of the development is hugely overcrowded and totally unsympathetic with the rest of the area. The three storey buildings are an eyesore which will take natural light and privacy away from the existing neighbours. There are plenty of other potential brownfield development plots in the Colne valley available, instead of destroying more grassland which is rich in natural wildlife. Once built its all too late to turn back. Flooding issues caused by the development are a big concern to the Manchester road residents, a huge amount of water is soaked up by this field in the winter months. Where will it be diverted to? The original plans for this development were supposed to be scaled back, now all that is different is a piece of land left empty for "future development" Has the developer really been sympathetic and scaled back the original plans?
