

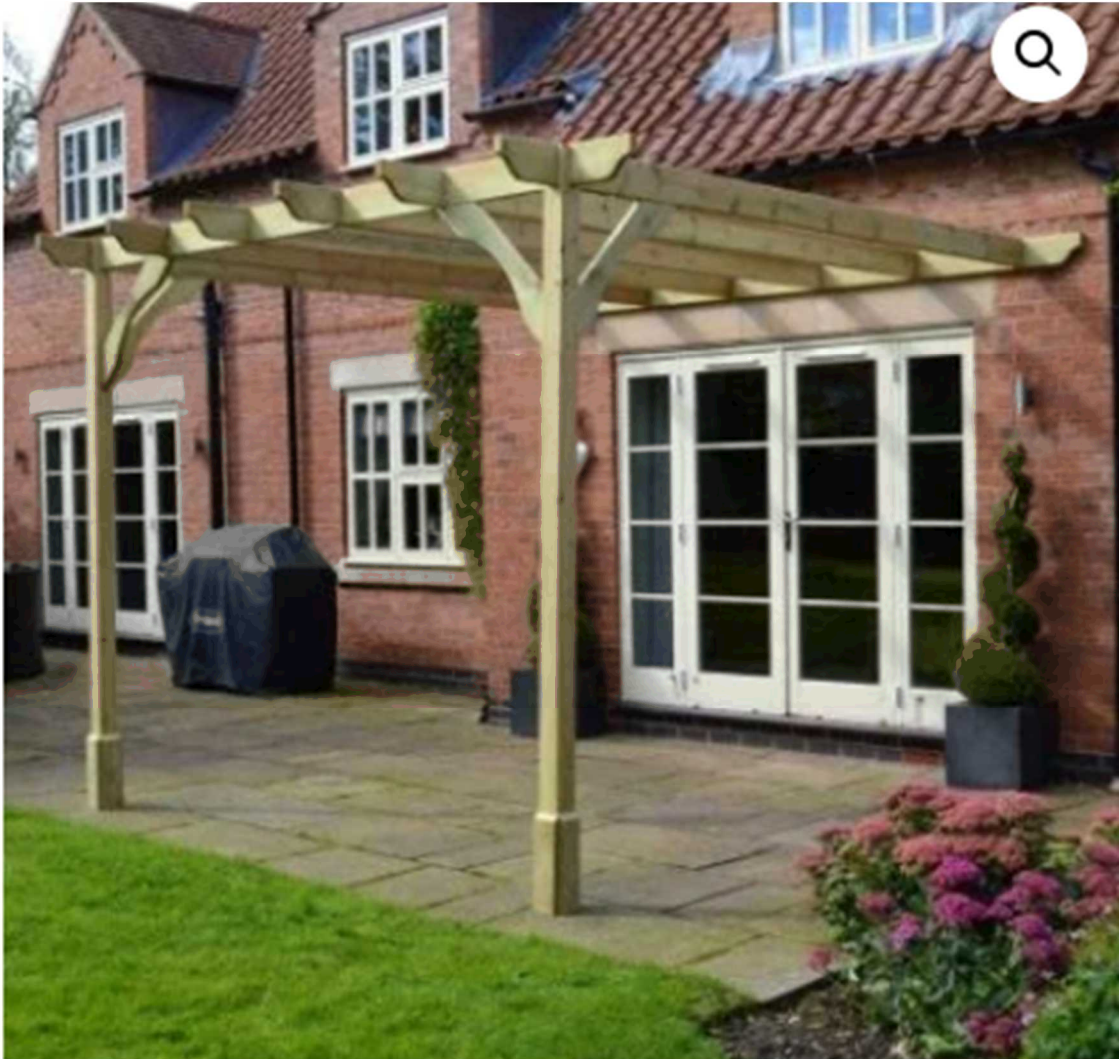
Point 1 on marked map – Decking and pergola

Decking is planned to be real wood effect composite decking from a company called Millboard (<https://millboard.co.uk/decking/weathered-oak>) to the appearance in character with the house, the 'vintage oak' with 'weathered oak' finish:



Height circa 20cm.

A 2 post lean to pergola made from the same composite wood as above is then being requested, in a style similar to the picture below, with only 5 slim overhead beams to minimise blocking sunlight into the living room.



Overall positioning should look a little like this. This particular wall is West facing so any reduction on sunlight entering the living room will only be minimal and only of an evening due to the position of the sun.



The decking is not strictly rectangular due to the curved dry stone wall, so the shape of the decking will be with the aim of providing a reasonable gap between the decking and the dry stone wall to ensure it is tidy.
