After viewing the application, including plans, I would like to object to the current application for the proposed extension to 132 South View Road, East Bierley, BD4 6PJ The height, size and closeness to my house would severely reduce the light to my home, in particular the landing (just one window and directly underneath is the docking station for my stairlift which I need to be able to see to get on). Bathroom (one window being the only source of daylight). Kitchen (as the extra building and added length will restrict the light there is and will overlook my kitchen and paved seating area). My main concern is the loss of privacy and loss of light. There are no specific measurements (on the plans) from the external wall of the extension to my drystone boundary walls but it looks extremely close. My house is very close to my drystone boundary wall (under one metre) The other concern is for the drystone boundary wall itself (part of which is the external wall of my old cottage). It is about 300 years old. I am concerned that any development too close to the wall will damage it. I am also worried about the need to maintain both walls and that there would not be enough space I do not object to the proposal to build a boundary wall in front of 132 South View Road
