Little Gomersal is one of the few villages with any beauty in the area. Moreover, it retains a quiet, safe and tranquil village atmosphere. The Wheatsheaf pub (opposite the site) is the centre of community gatherings where families enjoy the walk through the village and the views over the Spen valley. The pair of bungalows of which the site is one, blend seamlessly into the green belt. What is proposed however, appears to be the size of an hotel. It seems very imposing and completely out of character for a village with ordinary family houses. If something like this is built, the intangible things it takes away, things that Kirklees is trying to promote, cannot be undone. It seems to push all the boundaries to their limit and doesn't appear to respect the spirit of the law. I feel, with careful thought, there could be modifications which would make it much less of a 'carbuncle' (as HRH The Prince of Wales would say) on the face of this lovely village.
