As Chairman of the Springfield Residents Group at Springfield Court, Roberttown, I have been asked by a number of neighbours re-planning at 230 Roberttown Lane there and also my own view to appeal against planning for a terrace row of 3 houses with very limited

parking for 6 cars. Objections listed below.

A one or two houses project would be considered, but not built-in Red Brick should be built with the same block bricks as Springfield Court.

Objections to 6 cars with very limited parking, and parking on Roberttown lane would make the traffic flow worse than it already is with the car parking on the road with the terrace houses opposite.. There have been some bad accidents with traffic crossing from Commonside onto Roberttown Lane as well as the Buses that use Roberttown Lane with double parking on Roberttown Lane would prove a nightmare.

Strong objection to red built new Property and 2 levels new Property may as well cause objections.
