I have a number of objections, There were 2 trees that have been there for years, one was cut down today 16th March. They are repairing the house number 7, and they are there all day, I am working from home and they are loud with diggers, building walls and cutting trees down, building 2 houses will create a lot more noise and debris. Also highway, Thomas Street it backs on to is a very narrow road with cars parked, it is already difficult to navigate and the bin truck struggles to get through, it also backs on to the reverse of Lonsdale Terrace where I live and I have had to go and ask for the vans to be moved so I can get out, my concern is if there's 3 houses even with a parking space, some people will block me in and like my neighbour, when I go back to work I have to go early and can't be knocking on doors to get out, if the builders aren't considerate, and there isn't enough space for them now, it's going to be a real struggle when houses are there. The houses at Thomas street who's houses have been there for 100 years are going to be either over looked or have the sun blocked, the sun goes West to East. As I have mentioned neighbouring properties, the roads are narrow and already plenty of cars, it's difficult to get out of Thomas street onto Valley road now, and with an house near the corner visibility won't be great, and Valley Road is used as a race track now, visibility is paramount. We also have 2 air raid shelters, that have obviously been there for over 50 years, one has been used by a neighbour for a number of years, and these are an asset to the area, and we shouldn't lose these buildings, they should be incorporated, they are in good repair and not an hazard so there's no reason to lose them.
