Dear sir

With reference to planning application 2021/90791, 35 Henley Avenue, Thornhill, Dewsbury WF12 0LN.

Demolition of existing garage and erection of detached dwelling forming annexe accommodation.

I feel this application should be rejected for the following reasons:-

1) The Henley Avenue estate has been here since 1972 and is a well established area for families of 3 or 4 or 5. They should not be allowed to be used by the large numbers of family members that this annexe will be used for. The houses and garages have stood like this with little change for 50 years. To demolish this garage and build a two storey annexe would totally trash the aesthetic beauty of this corner of our lovely street. This would be an ugly carbuncle visible from everyones property in the area.

2) The current family who live here are already large in number and the number of cars regularly parked on this corner number 3 or 4 or 5 or often many more. During the lockdowns visitors have been coming in droves with many more cars present totally ignoring the lockdown rules and the law. These cars are often parked illegally across other peoples driveways and always on the pavement. They often park, sometimes for up to an hour and at all times of day and night with the engine running causing much noise and pollution. They arrive home at all hours making much more noise with slamming car doors and roaring engines. The cars are often noisy sporty types and they are driven on Henley Avenue as if it was a racetrack. often reaching speeds up to 50 or 60 MPH.

Everone feels that if more people moved in in this annexe this would mean even more cars and more noise and pollution and more disturbance. There are many elderly people living here and other conditions who already feel that the noise and pollution is excessive. There are also many families with small children in this corner all of whom are in danger from this kind of unacceptable driving behaviour.

I would hope that you consider these comments as my wife is receiving treatment and we should not be having to suffer more stress.
