My comments relate to the **west elevation** of the new industrial units proposed to be built behind the former Chartist Public House, Commercial Road, Skelmanthorpe, HD8 9DT.

I welcome industrial employment buildings built in the right place, and also retention of the exterior features of the former Chartist Pub.

However there should be some natural tree and shrub planting in front of the western elevation of the proposed industrial units - in order to soften the rather monolithic architecture; and also to provide some habitat for wildlife, thus helping enhance biodiversity that should now always be a feature of planning decisions - **ESPECIALLY** since it would seem that some mature trees may be felled?
