Further to this they want to remove the 12 foot high Hawthorne hedge and replace with a 6 foot wooden fence with laurel hedging(no height given) on their side. This hedge is on our land at our side of the perimeter fence which comes down from number 16 and we have maintained this our side for 40 years and lay claim to this. The area in question is a semi-woodland area and home to many wild animals and birds. There are bats that fly over at dusk and a fox family that come through looking for food. Roberttown has very little green space left and to remove further habitat is not necessary. I request that a biodiversity study is undertaken to prove the point.
