

1. Tree protection will be placed prior to retaining, connecting, any existing trees to be retained, and the construction of the contractor on site will be well as necessary protective measures as set out in BS 5837:2012.
2. Contractors to locate and protect any underground services.
3. All areas of proposed planting affected by construction works to be relieved of construction by exposing to a depth of 600mm, in two directions, to a depth of 100mm, in one direction, to be displaced soil. If water supply is likely to be disrupted, do not carry out planting until instructed. Retain any existing trees and shrubs. If conditions are suitable, do not plant during periods of frost or strong winds.
4. All groundworks and planting operations will be in accordance with BS 5837:2012 and BS 5838: Specification for Topsoil.
5. BS 4545 Code of Practice for General Landscaping.
6. BS 4545 Code for Nursery to Landscape in the Landscape.
7. Effective weed control will be carried out prior to construction of the planting area. The planting depth of 300mm, except within 4.0m of any existing tree stem.
8. All trees to be 300mm or less in diameter and shrubs 600mm or less in height. All trees and shrubs imported quality on site should be established. Use good quality top soil should be used.
