I would like to object to Planning Application reference 2021/62/91302/W for the following reasons:

- a) The existing footpath between Mount Road and Old Mount Road, which is extensively used by locals, visitors and wildlife alike, would be highly compromised by the increased traffic use of private, commercial and service providers' vehicles caused by the development.
- b) Drainage in the area, known for its high rainfall, would be adversely affected as both Mount Road and Old Mount Road already struggle to cope in times of heavy rainfall.
- c) Wildlife in the area would be adversely affected. The destruction of habitat would reduce the population of insects that are so uniquely vital in pollinating plants and feeding the birds and others that rely on them, causing irreparable damage to the whole structure of wildlife in this uniquely beautiful valley.
- d) By reducing the amount of green space in the environment there is a corresponding loss in the tree and plant life that do so much in preventing the build up of harmful greenhouse gases in the atmosphere.
- e) The Peak District National Park is an area of outstanding natural beauty and a vital breathing space in between the conurbations of Leeds and Manchester. Whereas this plot is not actually in the Park it is within metres of it and as a consequence is close enough to affect the beauty of Butterley Reservoir and The Wessenden Valley.
