I have attached photo's below of the tree I am concerned about. As far as I can tell the tree is dead and has been for a number of years. As mentioned a large branch fell a couple of weeks ago which drew my attention to the issue. You can visible see the upper branches have begun to decay hence a lot of branches has fallen in the short time we have owned the property. I have approached a local tree surgeon and confirmed the tree is dead as well. I will await your reply before I arrange for the tree to be removed.

I write with regards to your enquiry seeking advice on the potential removal of a dead tree at 22 North Road Kirkburton.

Having checked our plans the property is located within the local conservation area, therefore an application will need to be submitted before any works can be undertaken. An application form and guidance notes can be found on our web site at:

www.kirklees.gov.uk/trees

However, if the tree is dead and causing an imminent risk of danger then there is an exemption from the normal application process. To do this you would need to send 5 days written notice of your intention to remove a dead-dangerous tree supported by a photo to show that the tree is dead and dangerous. This can simply be sent to this email address.
