<p>I must ask that the planners view the vehicular access lane between 2a & 2 st Mary's Lane that is still on the submitted design access statement as a pedestrian access , no photos submitted show the facts of this & all reference is to a foot path . The Lane serves at least 30 vehicle movements a day & must be considered in its proximity to the entrance to the site off St Mary's Lane , the Lane initially served as vehicular access for the mill sites horses & carts & has been in existence & noted for the 1910 land valuation documents , for the developer to simply gloss over facts of road safety rather than present true facts to the authorities is a real concern to me and my family , please come to site and see the how close the two accesses are , if the developers refuse to issue the true facts and evidence to help you make a safe & informed decision on road safety you must look further to elevate my concerns or find a safe solution to the new developments access . This is my only concern & I champion the development but not at the cost of my family being involved in a road traffic incident that could be avoided by risk assessing the situation & finding a safe solution at planning stage .</p>
