

Heritage Statement

E023641 - Jerk House, 160 Manchester Road, HUDDERSFIELD, HD1 3JA

Reason for work

We have installed an Automated Teller Machine to provide a 24 hour banking facility for the local community and visitors to the area.

Site Area

We have installed an ATM to the right hand side of the main entrance at Jerk House. The ATM has been installed through an existing glazing panel as a through glazing installation.

The property is situated within a residential and commercial area, we consider that the installation of this ATM would not be detrimental to the existing street scene.

The property is a Grade II listed building and comprises of a pitched stone slate roof, it is a 3 storey property with Stone brackets to gutter and 4 ranges of sashes on each of the upper 2 floor. The property is early mid-19th century and the shopfront is late C19 shopfront.

Impact on building

The components and materials used are sympathetic to the local area, great care was taken when work was done on the building. The ATM does not affect any existing architectural features and the integrity of the property.

Taken in context of the building and shop front, the ATM and signage are in proportion to the existing shopfront features. Any works done to the exterior of the building would be easily reversed and replaced to match with the existing frontage and return it to its previous state.
