I support these plans. I have grown up in the area a stones throw from the house in question. Most of the negative comments in this section can't be from people who would be directly affected by the proposed plans as only 2 residential houses have land that backs directly onto the property (the rest is a field and a road) and there are 3 homes across the road. By this simple maths 5 out of the 33 (so far) complaints may be valid, the rest are from people who care more about their own property prices than children who need help. These complaints are probably from people who can't even see the house let alone who knew that as a respite home it already looked after people with mental and physical disability. Some of the comments in this section make me feel sick, these are children that need help not dangerous criminals. As i've grown up in the countryside, I truly believe that being away from towns and cities is the best way to help mental health and, with the right support, it could benefit these children immensely. Also 5 children is the size of a large family, that's not the size of a detention centre, it's the size of a family unit which is something that these children probably need. I support these plans fully, I am ashamed that people in my area have written these children off without even giving them a chance.
