**Prior notification for single storey rear extension**

I refer to your submission of details relative to the proposed extension as described below for the above property and as submitted on 27-Apr-2021.

The proposal is for erection of single storey rear extension. The extension projects 3.1m beyond the rear wall of the original dwellinghouse. The maximum height of the extension is 4m, the height of the eaves of the extension is 3m

The Authority has considered your application and it has been determined that the proposal is not acceptable and prior approval is hereby **Refused** for the following reason(s);

The proposed extension fails to comply with Class A, Part 1 of Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development)(England) 2015 (as amended). This is because the flat roofed side projection currently erected at the dwelling is not classified to be part of the original dwellinghouse. Therefore, the proposed extension goes beyond a side elevation of the original dwellinghouse and has a width more than half the width of the original dwelling thus failing to comply with paragraph (j) of Class A.

### Appeals to the Secretary of State

If you are aggrieved by the decision of the Local Planning Authority to refuse details of the proposed development, you may appeal to the Secretary of State under Section 78 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within **twelve weeks** of the date of issue of this notice.

The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of a notice of appeal but will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of appeal.

Please note, only the applicant possesses the right of appeal.
