Heckmondwike road is a very busy road and particularly at that area as there is currently two shops and leading to a nursery and primary school on one side and a nursery on the other with no area to use for stopping, so cars are always parked on main road to offload children as it is which restricts the flow of traffic. Spen view estate has only one way in and one way out for hundred of houses out onto Heckmondwike road just down from the proposed site, which again is difficult to get out of at busy periods. Also just down from proposed site is a large rugby club which only has small area for parking at rear. Parking for the club is sometimes the length of the road including where the proposed site is. On top of that there is already a petrol station on this road approximately 1 mile away and do not see the need for another so close by. There are two large shopping centres in either direction being Morrison's and ASDA which both have onsite petrol stations which most people will use when they do their food shopping. I feel this isn't the best use of land in the local area, if you ask local people what is needed in the area I'm sure a petrol station will be last on the list - this will not enhance the local community in any way, just bring more congestion and pollution to an already over congested and polluted area
