Having spoken against the proposed development at the previous Planning meeting, I am unfortunately unable to attend on Thursday. There are many reasons why this application should be refused, not least the fact that the proposed development will rob the area of one of its last green spaces. Also, having brought attention to the present traffic difficulties for residents of Mill Lane, I am astounded that the Council has not decided to include this road in a traffic survey. Indeed I would ask if any Councillor has seen fit to do a site visit to the roundabout at the end of Grange Road and Mill Lane to see the congestion there twice a day during rush hours at present? The "rat run" situation continues throughout the day on Mill Lane, whilst drivers try to avoid being slowed down by the traffic calming on Grange Road and Challenge Way. Why is the Council ignoring the need to re-develop Brownfield sites in the area, as opposed to using up this precious green resource? Why is the Council ignoring the Government's Green Agenda which demands that Brownfield sites must be re-developed, and that no more Greenbelt should even be considered for development?
