I work at Northorpe Hall and the traffic currently using the lane is already at maximum capacity. The green that is being proposed to be used as a lay-by is owned by Northorpe Hall charity and not the council. The volume of traffic using Northorpe lane and Crossley lane creates bottlenecks during school times. Both lanes are country lanes and are too narrow to even have white lines down the middle of the road. The additional number of cars for the proposed number of housing will push the roads to breaking point. In addition both lanes are not suitable for the construction vehicles that will be needed to access to site. Consideration also needs to be given to . Additional traffic and construction vehicles are not conducive to their needs. Walkers and horse riders who already regularly use the road and adjoining Crossley lane have to be careful due to the current level of traffic without the addition of another circa 90 cars from the additional proposed housing. Does the field of the proposed site not act as a buffer zone and was originally green belt lane.
