Re: Application number 2021/91914

I refer to my comments from June 2021 (reference number is FS-Case-342266562) and wish to renew my objections to this application.

The previous concerns about this development are still valid. The Council's Conservation & Design Consultancy team criticised the previous plans because of lack of separation from existing properties and I cannot see how this is any improvement. Reducing the number of houses by just 2 does not make this site any more acceptable than it was before, in fact it actually makes matters worse and is less compliant with the requirements of the Conservation & Design Consultancy team than it was before. How can this be allowed?

Basically, there are too many houses being built in this location which will double the size of the village. It will be completely at odds with the historic character of this area and does not fit in with either the appearance of the existing houses or the location in which they are situated.

Building 2 less houses makes no real difference to the amount of traffic that will be created so it will still cause additional problems for the local roads and is a serious road safety risk for local residents.

As the overall size and type of this development has really not changed at all, it is still as unacceptable as it was before, so it seems pointless that the builder has submitted this information. Only genuine changes should be considered and to be of any use at all, this would involve a significant reduction in the number of houses. The current proposal has still not solved any of the problems that have been highlighted so many times previously and makes no difference the negative impact such an estate would have.

What is the purposes of all these additional documents? It just seems to be a pointless exercise. This is still an ill-conceived plan for a housing estate in the wrong place. The planning application should be refused.
