Here are my objections to the above application.

There are still no plans for the proposed layby on Northorpe Hall's grass verge. The only information I have found about the proposed layby was dated 2021, and has not been seen since.

On the last plans there were 39 houses and suddenly it has become 44, with 9 of these units marked as "affordable". Ten visitors parking spaces are available for 44 homes, I wonder where the extra cars will be parked!

Again we have been given only 6 days to get our objections into the Planning Department, two of these days are at the weekend. The deadline finishes on the 12<sup>th</sup> and yet a meeting is called on Wednesday the 14<sup>th</sup> to make a decision on the development. This, in your letter, is after you tell us that there could be delays in processing, disruption to the postal service and you having limited resources. You then warn, if our comments are received late, the applications may have been determined. This to me is both threatening and completely unreasonable (suggesting the odds are stacked in your favour).

The Council is there to service the people, not to bully them.
