The properties 2,4, 6 and possibly 13 Leefield Road have a public footpath running through the gardens which does not appear have been dealt with when they were built. The plan below shows the location of the remaining section of White Lee Side adjacent to Leefield Road shown on 1:2500 National Grid 1st revision published 1970. The 1985 definitive map also shows the footpath running adjacent to Leefield Road. This is footpath Heckmondwike 3.

This property appears to have been sold in 2020, I have asked for details if the Council did the property search. Since 2016 rights of way questions are mandatory on the Con29 property search form. Either way this will need to be dealt with. The proposed development does not appear to extend in the direction of the footpath and Prow does not have an objection in principle to the extension.
