Looking at the proposed attenuation tank and lake, I would like clarification as to where the run off from the lake discharges to. It appears the run off will discharge into the upper section of Bradley Park Dyke through the culvert under the motorway. This culvert discharges on the south side of shepherds thorn lane in the field, then follows a path to a sink pipe under the road at the "Throstle Nest" site. The dip or lowest point of Shepherds Thorn Lane already floods in heavy rain as the drain or culvert under the road blocks. The Dyke then find another route flooding the field and running over Shepherds Thorn Lane causing flooding and blocking access to the Scout camp. The road is flooded so often that the retaining wall is being weakened and washed away. If it is the case that development goes ahead and the run off is going to take this route, then a major upgrade will be needed to the Dykes culvert running under Shepherds Thorn Lane, otherwise the lane will eventually be severely damaged and access to Bradley Wood will be cut off.
