

Jeff Huddersfield Edgerton Elm tree TPO application - HU1/71/t13

E1 -ELM

There is an Elm tree on the SE side of the property on number 8 Edgerton Road, Huddersfield. This Elm tree is close to the owner's home in his garden and the tree is over the border of his neighbour's land. This Elm tree has got quite large and the owner is requesting that it be removed. The tree's canopy is dominating the surrounding area which consists of a driveway and part of the garden. The owner and the neighbour both would like it to be removed with consent from the council. The owner is planning on putting a hedge there in its replacement, and putting down turf around there as he wants to grow flowers underneath. The owner doesn't like how close it is to his house and states it ruins the amount of light he and his neighbour get below it.

If however the tree inspection officer deems it totally unsuitable to remove, we are proposing to reduce the canopy to a manageable shape / size, to thin the tree by 20% and to lift a few of the low hanging branches.
