In this instance, highway officers would stipulate that a 9.5m highway (5.5m carriageway and 2x2.0m footways) can be achieved with a minimum junction radius of 6.0m. It would seem that this cannot be accommodated whilst the restaurant building is retained and HDM would therefore ask that this is demonstrated on a plan to ensure a workable scheme can be provided.

Further to this I could only give more general advice in terms of detailed design (off-street parking levels, refuse collection, emergency vehicle access etc.), although it may be felt this is more appropriate at the next stage of proceedings.
