As a local resident of Farnley Tyas I strongly object to the new developments at Yew Tree Farm for a number of reasons. Firstly, I have major concerns about the amount of traffic this will bring to the village. In the three years I have lived in the village, traffic has increased dramatically, with no speed bumps or cameras, I already feel unsafe walking my baby through the village because of the speed of cars and the amount of cars. This new development is going to make traffic even worse, in what is supposed to be a small, rural village. Secondly I moved to the area because it was as I mentioned previously- a small, rural and quiet village. This development will totally take away the character of the area, likely affecting other house prices. Many people live in Farnley Tyas because they want to live in the countryside, not on a housing estate. It IS encroaching on green belt land and a public footpath runs around the back, between the farm and the church. We have lots of walkers in the area, who will now see a building site rather than the views towards Emley. Again ruining our beautiful countryside and natural environment. Has the capacity of the school been considered?
