With reference to the above numbered planning applications at Yew Tree Farm, Farnley Tyas, I would like to raise my continued concerns.

Amended plans have recently been submitted but they do not fully address the concerns raised in my previous correspondence.

- 1.The height, scale and materials on the new builds do not appear to have been changed.
- 2.There is still a significant incursion into the Green Belt.
- 3.The established and mature tree T4 is still to be removed.

This prominent site in the centre of the Conservation Area of Farnley Tyas should surely be developed in a sympathetic way and not consist of new builds that are significantly higher than all the listed buildings actually contained therein plus all the listed buildings that directly surround the site.

These applications, in their present form, have a detrimental impact on the Conservation Area of Farnley Tyas. I respectfully request that they are refused and new plans requested that reflect the importance of this site in preserving the character of this Conservation Area.
