Dear Kirklees Planning

I am writing to object to the above application due to the loss of local amenity, highway safety, increased traffic to the immediate area and lack of consultation with the tenants.

The application wrongly asserts that the garages are not fit for purpose due to size, however, this is incorrect. Over many years of tenancy, I have parked large and small vehicles as well as motorbikes and bicycles perfectly well.

Knowl Grove is often over parked and difficult to negotiate, to add more homes and remove off street parking will result in even more footway parking. It's not just the garages in question, there is parking on the garage site as well. I have spoken to elderly and disabled residents who were not aware of the application and very concerned and unclear how to raise concerns when they lacked the skills and means to object on-line.

I also wish to raise objection to the lack of consultation with the tenants - many of which - like myself - have had the garages for many years.

Before making a decision, I would urge you to visit residents and see the street for yourself. Unlike 'traditional' estates, the residents are not computer literate and vulnerable so deserve special consideration.
