We put planning in for an extension</p> <p>and this got refused. If this planning goes ahead it will severely reduce the amount of sunlight coming into my room as well as greatly reduce my privacy and means I will be overlooked with them being able to directly see into my bedroom. It will greatly impact on the privacy we have currently and make it increasingly noisy especially with the building work which I am already experiencing whilst trying to work from home. It also will block my view and the sunlight which I get on an afternoon and evening making my room very dark and severely impact the living conditions especially when I work from home which means more than likely my family will have to spend more money on electricity to light the rooms during the day which of course impacts on the environment. My Great Granddad owned all of the farm and wished for the land to stay as farm buildings and not be developed into any houses to maintain the landscape and not to destroy the peacefulness of the neighbouring properties. Not to mention there are several animals that live on the farm such as barn owls, cats and bats, which all these houses and building works will destroy and disturb their habitat. Which seriously impacts the conservation of the natural habitat. I've lived my whole life and being grateful to enjoy the peacefulness and privacy and this proposed planning will seriously my effect my family's wellbeing due to a significant reduction of privacy and increased noise levels and disturbance.
