I am writing to you as a resident of the above address and I and many other people are going to be very badly affected by the Proposed access road down Park View, I don't think this was in the previous application when the access road was going to be on Wakefield Road.

Park View is a small complex of only 12 Bungalows built approx 21 years ago

for over 55 years old and disabled people,
of which I am one now aged 83 years old

- I use a mobility scooter
to get about and there are many
things on Park View which affect us
- ① The Doctors + chemist cause a lot of
extra Traffic with the disruption that
goes with this,
 - ② There is a notice on Park View put
up by the Police saying access only
to Numbers 1 to 12 Inclusive, this is
not enforced and a large number
of large + small vehicles using Park
View as a turning point 24/7
any further transport would most
likely cause damage to the block

Paving on Park View.

- ③ The curb on the Pavement of Park View is I would estimate a foot steep in places and is extremely difficult for people with walking difficulties, also people with prams and people with mobility scooters, we also have a very large number of dog walkers coming with their pets into the park for walks as I said a very large number daily many who have two three or 4 dogs has this been taken into account
- ④ People including all I have mentioned plus many more will be affected by the steep bends in the road which are very narrow and there is only room for 2 cars to pass. If & when when building commences it will

affect the Quality and Way of life for the residents of Park View a lot of us on this small Cul de Sac have lots of everyday Problems and difficulties in life which you are adding to Greatly.

⑤ Also because Park View is Occupied by old people many with Health Problems. we must have access to Fire Brigade Ambulance & Police if and when Needed and delays could have very Serious outcomes.

Last but not least Please consider The Aged and Infirm for whom life is already a Struggle.

(b) just one further point we have at least 3 Bungalows who have Carers coming in on a regular Basis 1 Bungalow the occupants are both in their mid 90's and have them 4 times a day, another resident has them at least twice a day because she has [redacted] and has to be supervised with Tablets and another just once a day. The Carers need access to their clients at all times and would also be affected by the disruption.
