This house has been in my family since it was built and has been my home whilst growing up and will be my offspring's childhood home, we have 3 windows overlooking onto the field, this was once a beautiful field full of nature, where you could sit and watch the birds and foxes in the day time and the owls and bats on the night time, I spent all of my childhood playing and exploring this field with my brother.

This piece of natural land was destroyed by people who didn't have permission or gave warning to the residents that they was ripping it up. Since this has happened my view is destroyed buy big piles of rubbish left behind, mature trees were cut down that have been there for as long as I can remember. They broke through the wall off of Fullwood drive removed all of the original drystone wall that created the boundary line. They put up Harris fencing and a toilet in the middle of the road blocking parking access to residents, they scrapped up all of the road, and destroyed the old pond as well as peoples allotments. Since they have done the work pulling up the field it has made my boundary wall weak and it's is starting to subside, causing me to fork out to try and fix the issue.

Our road is full enough with 21 houses, cars have to park on the road / pavement as it is because our road is tight, we have children who can play safely on the road at the moment, there is a flooding issue that come from the houses on the topside of the road, this is already a hazard in the winter because the road becomes an ice ring, pulling out at the end of our road is dangerous for the people who already live here.

Our privacy has already been impacted by the other houses that are across the field, I do not want more houses building next door to mine, my grandad planted the conifers at the top of my drive when they purchased the house, I don't want these removing.

I highly object to these homes getting built the nature has only just started to return, this is habited to bats, newts, owls and foxes, there is also Indian balsam that grows in the field, our homes have already been impacted with the others getting built I don't want more.
