<p>My main objections are about the use of Greenbelt land for this proposed (very large) installation which would, I feel, dramatically change our local rural scene for the worse, and I am also concerned about the wider consequences of losing so much agricultural land. I personally feel that solar farms should be built on brownfield sites in preference to areas of outstanding natural beauty such as this.</p> <p>The UK has recently been exposed as one of the worst-rated nations for the extent to which its natural biodiversity is disappearing, and I think that in addition to governments, local councils ought to take some responsibility for some of their cavalier planning decisions over recent decades.</p> <p>This lovely area and its walkways provides so much pleasure to many people and this proposal feels completely at odds with a general desire to protect our beautiful countryside and its wildlife for future generations of Kirklees citizens. Please let us put a halt to any further degradation of the Greenbelt.</p>
