Further to our emails I am formally objecting to the proposed solar farm.

The solar farm has not been applied for correctly. It is too large a site/ project for Kirklees to approve and should therefore go to the Secretary of State.

The company Boom have failed to hold any open meetings with the local councillors and have failed to give residents an open forum for Q&A sessions.

The application shows a building/ structure that will block my views and be in direct eye line from my home. You, yourself cannot answer what this will be used for, what it will contain, the amount of access that will be needed.

There have been no comparative sites or feasibility studies included in the application.

We are loosing too much green belt countryside. There are much more accessible areas within Kirklees that are already brown belt and should be investigated further before this application is even considered.

Please confirm you have my formal objection to this incomplete, under prepared and incorrectly submitted application.
