Dear Planning Committee,

I write to you in relation to planning application number 2021/93689.

Being a local resident, I am aware the previous application/s relating to the building of homes had a lot of public interest, with many objections.

Despite this, It is disappointing how planning was only submitted a few days prior, with very little time given to comment on the matter.

I am saddened that being a local resident who objected to the previous application, I only received a letter informing of this application today, with only 1 day left to submit any comments.

Secondly, upon speaking with the Masjid Abu Bakr committee and Lees Hall Playgroup they have confirmed the Council has not had any discussions with them or reached a viable arrangement despite the mosque and playgroups and their representatives following-up on this consistently. Can you confirm why the council has not involved these 2 essential parties in such essential discussions and decisions?

Ravensthorpe Road and Lees Hall Road both remain extremely busy, causing constant traffic and disruption. I am concerned that the the proposed plans will only increase the traffic and noise. I am afraid this will only further increase the chaos and disruption we face on a daily basis.

Having been given only one day to comment on this, I have not been able to express the many issues and concerns relating to this, but would be able to elaborate should the window be extended.
