Regarding the application 2021/93689, I would like to say how deeply concerning it is how late I was informed about the plans for Masjid Abu Bakr Nursery/Lees Hall Community Centre. I only just received the letter in the post on the 24th of October, which gives me less than 24 hours to comment before the due date, which is the 25th of October. This is insufficient time for me to assess and respond accordingly.

I have also received news that the management at Lees Hall Community Centre have not been told any necessary information about this planning permission at all, which is irresponsible and unacceptable. We are not against the building of houses; we are aware that this is necessary; all we ask for is the decency to be given what we need and be informed.

After having a disastrous time with Covid 19, we need the community to be closer than ever, and the Lees Road Community Centre contributes to the well-being of people living near the centre. I personally know people who work at the nursery, and to have this planning permission accepted would mean that they would be out of a job. In times of the cost of living rising, this is the last thing they need.

As a young member of this generation, I am also concerned, regarding the traffic that will increase if permission is handed in. This will only increase pollution and contribute to the climate crisis we are currently facing.
