I am writing concerning the planning application number 2021/93689 - one that I have previously and numerously objected to for reasons the council is well aware of.

As someone who regularly uses the amenity, both for prayer at Masjid Abu Bakr and the nursery at Lees Hall Playgroup, I am deeply saddened and rightly appalled to learn that the council have not conceded to any agreement which takes into consideration the needs of the management, community, or local service providers and users or their stakeholders.

Having previously objected on grounds of poor planning, congestion, need, various pollution, failure to provide suitable and sufficient alternative or consider the concerns of community members, the way in which this particular application has been sought and residents have been informed bears stark testimony to the fact that the council, sadly, seeks to eliminate local residents and services and their concerns from the discussion.
