Further to the existing objection(s) raised by my neighbour(s), I object to the above planning permission submission for the following reasons: I live nearby the planned development and building of a home on the plot will obstruct my view of the surrounding countryside. The building will not be in keeping with the style of property in the are which are predominantly Victorian terraces. OLNEY STREET is already full to capacity when it comes to car parking. So much so that vehicles are forced to park on every available space up to the junction with MEAL HILL LANE and at the opposite extreme right down to the allotments at the dead end of OLNEY STREET. Parking is often illegal and dangerous, with parking at a premium. The addition of yet another property and two private parking spaces on a driveway would restrict the parking on that side of the street that is currently utilised It will also add a further two vehicles to the street. I fear that this would be a detriment to road safety on an already full to capacity location. It would cause further congestion. In summary I also object, as the building is not in keeping with the area in terms of aesthetics, it will overlook other properties, obscure countryside views of the hills and cause further congestion on an already full to capacity street vehicular traffic wise. The building of the properties would also cause considerable disruption to the elderly residents in the sheltered accommodation neighbouring the plots and to other residents.
