

I refer to the planning notice dated 1st February, 2022, which was posted at the junction of Briestfield Road and Healey Lane.

I wish to object to permission being granted.

The property in question is on a single track bridleway, which passes Cleveland Farm and Cleveland Lodge.

There is building work, adding extensions to Lower Sowood Farm, going on at the moment, and it has been underway for quite some time now.

We've had HGVs delivering supplies during this time, and those vehicle are ruining the verges when they have to make multi-point turns to negotiate the T junction.

How many different lots of extensions and re-development work that create so much disturbance are to be allowed?

We've put up with these problems for months already, and we don't want them to continue, especially as we near the end of winter, and we want to be enjoying outdoor life again.

It seems very likely that having another residence on that road will create yet more motor vehicular traffic on a bridleway that is already unsafe for horse riders, cyclists, and pedestrians.
