Type of comment: An objection Do you wish your comments to be published on the website anonymously? Yes I object to this proposal on the grounds of traffic and road safety. It seems inconceivable that a quiet residential area with a single lane access road could support hundreds of additional vehicle movements at peak traffic times, especially since the proposal would see worker access vehicles having to form a long queue on said road to gain access to the site. We have seen with the recent roadworks on the M62 that any blockage on the M62 around Jct 26 causes drivers to use Scholes as a cut through with dozens of vehicles causing safety and congestion issues in the village. Imagine the chaos on a daily basis with hundreds of additional vehicles in the village. Secondly the proposal doesn't justify where HGV drivers who are early can go, one can imagine them clogging up the layby on the A58, or parking up on narrow residential streets to wait for their slot. There is no clarity on the emergency situation if HGV's cannot get to the site via the A58. The main road through Scholes village to access the Whitechapel entrance is not suitable for multiple HGV transit, as is evident to anyone who has witnessed a Co-op delivery lorry causing carnage in the village trying to deliver to the local shop.
