I am writing to express my concerns for this particular application. 1.) This development risks damage to green belt land which is vital in promoting biodiversity in a reality of climate change. A permanent structure such of this rips up land, displaces wildlife and creates various forms of pollution. 2.) This application is inaccurate. The application form claims the internal floor space is 82.4sqm but the plans show it to be 130sqm... which of the two is it? Further, it claims that the stables are British Horse Society (BHS) standard size which, for the record is 3.65m x 3.65m, but on the plans they are 5m x 5m – this is a huge overdevelopment and factually incorrect. 3.) Where will cars that will be accessing this stables park? Parking on the road would be dangerous for other road uses and pedestrians. Also, it should be noted in the updated highway code, drivers can no longer park on pavements... 4.) This application has been previously rejected and there is nothing new in this updated application that counters for any of the objections last time. No consideration for the local area, environment, or community. No change of building materials. Nothing has been taken on board. 5.) There is no mention of how the waste of four horses will be stored and disposed of. No one wants to walk by a field full of horse waste, and people living in Stocksmoor certainly don't want to be looking at it from their houses.
