Good afternoon

I went on the website to object the planning application for oddfellows Street 34 dwellings BD19.

I am a home owner on Salisbury Road which is adjacent to the field of which planning is proposed. The access to our street either side of Salisbury road, oddfellows or towngate is extremely awkward. There are residents parked on all entrances and this makes it a single traffic road. I've often had to back out onto the the main road of scholes Lane when turning in due to other traffic and this is without the additional traffic these houses will produce. It will be impossible to gain access to our own streets.

Our scholes will not be able to accommodate the addition children in the village. Most past the co op did not get in to whitcliffe Mount and will have to source schools elsewhere. Our village is not equipped to handle any more residents. The main village itself is terribly busy. Local facilities such as gp surgeries are full I myself have to travel to low moor to see a gp & I've lived in scholes 35 years & I could never get any closer.

Even if planning does pass I'm not sure how materials will get to the field as the access will not allow for anything larger than a tractor to get passed the parked cars. Which also park on scholes Lane so you cannot see when pulling out of oddfellows Street which is an accident waiting to happen.
