I strongly object to this planning application, we as a family will be directly impacted.

The air quality for those near to the development will suffer pollution due to vehicles entering and manoeuvring on site, particularly HGV vehicles shunting, we and other householders in the area have young children whose health can be adversely affected by this unnecessary development when playing in the back garden and breathing in the fumes.

Our property backs onto this proposed development. The majority of bedrooms are at the rear of the house, additional noise is unwelcome and this may well affect people's sleep patterns which in turn can affect their health. As well as additional noise, the many lights will add to light pollution potentially further affecting the sleep of those neighbouring this proposed development.

The larger units are situated closest to existing housing, this is totally unacceptable. The existing houses will be cast into the shadows and daylight will be reduced significantly and vehicles will pollute the air directly around people's homes. I see there is a proposal for some woodland, this again will only serve to block daylight from the existing housing. These units are far too big to be in such close proximity to residential properties.

When the weather permits, we do not want to sit in our back gardens in the shadows of industrial units breathing in vehicle fumes thank you very much.

I am very concerned about potential run off from any large tarmacked areas that could flood the back garden that already gets standing water during the autumn and winter. I would not want water entering my home due to this development.

The roads around Lindley are already at very busy at peak times, Weatherhill Road is very narrow in places and many children use this route to catch a bus or walk to school, including my own. Bringing in additional traffic on this and the other surrounding local roads is not welcome and poses a danger to pedestrians and cyclists. I'm sure this will inevitably result in HGVs travelling down roads not built for such traffic.

A more suitable plot of land for such a development is that where the Wappy Spring sits as there is no adjacent housing.
