Kirklees Council have already received our objections to the proposed development of 80 properties, however I wish to further object to the proposed alterations at the junction of Hermitage Park and Rowley Lane. These proposed alterations directly impact our grounds and there has been absolutely no consultation with ourselves on these proposals. I have serious concerns that there is no proper detail as to the boundary of our property, no detail about any retaining work required to prevent our garden and property collapsing onto Rowley Lane nor has there been any consideration given to the badgers, hedgehogs and foxes who live in the banking and use it as a route through to our garden. As many local residents have already highlighted, the junction has very poor visibility and the proposed alterations will have little, if any, impact in improving this. The danger at the junction is caused by the bend in Rowley Lane. I am also appalled to see that the developers have disregarded in their entirety the concerns raised by so many local residents with regards the traffic and parking issues caused by the local school. Vehicles from an additional 80 properties are only going to exacerbate these dangers and will inevitably result in a serious accident involving a child. Many photographs have been submitted which demonstrate the extent of the problem residents face on a daily basis, yet the developers have taken no action to address the issue.
