I strongly object to the erection of Unit 01 and 02, 2 detached dwelling sin the middle of true, dormer and chalet bungalows, they will be totally out of character with the area. They will look directly into properties over the northern boundary causing a loss of privacy. The dormer and Juliet balcony windows facing north are absolutely unacceptable to myself and neighbours privacy. It is a well known fact that there is a shortage of bungalows, it would be far more appropriate to build bungalows in the position of Units 01 and 02 with any dormer and Juliet balcony windows facing south. On the planning application form the following question has been answered "NO" : "Are there tress and hedges on the proposed development site?". This answer is not correct. There are two trees and a beech hedge on the northern boundary which gives privacy to properties over the northern boundary. Birds nest in the trees and hedging. I object to the possibility that these are destroyed like the rest of the trees and greenery on the site have been, ruining the appearance of the local area. I request that this planning application is refused please.
