<p>i'm concerned about the ever increasing amount of traffic through the village which has become worse with other recent housing developments. There have been accidents including damages to property and the vehicles of those of us who have to park on the street. There have been a number of incidents where our cars have been damaged and the offending driver has driven away. There should be a 20mph speed limit and speed bumps . Increasing housing will only contribute to this problem and i think it is only a matter of time before someone is injured or worse.</p> <p>TRaffic is frequently backed up along paris.</p> <p>I also feel that more traffic in this area will compound the problem of getting around the village during school rush hour which can be highly problematic as it is.</p> <p>Also there seems to have been no consideration upon the impact of aces to local services with it now being very difficult to get an appointment with a local GP. Although our GP practices are excellent it has become blatantly apparent that it accessing services has become a growing problem.</p> <p>I would also like to point out the impact on local residents with building works . We regularly have rds dug up due to drainage problems and preparation for utilities for new housing developments. We have traffic lights placed unthoughtfully restricting access to our properties and resulting in abuse from other drivers when we dare to turn into our drive or drive through a red light because we are in the middle of 2 sets of traffic lights so can't see what colour the lights are. When complaints are made we are almost bullied into agreeing the case has been resolved. This disruption goes on with little work seeming to go on at times.</p>
