The Coal Authority is a non-departmental public body sponsored by the Department of Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy. As a statutory consultee, The Coal Authority has a duty to respond to planning applications and development plans in order to protect the public and the environment in mining areas.

The Coal Authority Response: Fundamental Concern

I have reviewed the proposals and confirm that the application site falls within the defined Development High Risk Area; therefore within the application site and

surrounding area there are coal mining features and hazards which need to be considered in relation to the determination of this planning application.

Our records indicate that a coal outcrop runs through the site and this may have been subject to unrecorded workings at shallow depth. If workings are present within the outcrop these may pose a potential risk to surface stability and public safety.

In accordance with the agreed risk-based approach to development management in the defined Development High Risk Areas, the applicant should be informed that they need to submit a Coal Mining Risk Assessment Report to support this planning application. As no relevant information has been submitted at this time the Coal Authority **objects** to this planning application.

The Coal Authority would be very pleased to receive for further consultation and comment any additional information submitted by the applicant.
