Dear Mr Simcock,

Re: Planning application 2022/70/93158/W for "Former Homecare DIY", by Mr Balraj Uppal

I wish to object in the strongest terms to this application to change what is currently Playworld, primarily a childrens' play and leisure facility, to an "indoor sports and recreation unit".

Mr Uppal now asks for opening hours "9.00 am to 12.30 pm (presumably this means to 12.30 am i.e. after midnight) on Saturdays and Sundays and 9.00 am to 11.30 pm Sunday to Thursday. This does not appear to make sense as Sunday has two different finishing times and Friday is not covered at all; in any case such a late finish would have an extremely detrimental impact on our local community.

This would include:

- unacceptable noise late at night close to many residential family houses, especially in Syringa Street, Mint Street, Imperial Road and Cleveland Road, many of these include young children whose sleep patterns are likely to be disturbed
- increased traffic late at night on these and other nearby roads
- light pollution from car headlights and the lights surrounding the building and car park
- increased car parking spilling on to local streets which are already frequently packed with vehicles parked partly on pavements and grass verges

On behalf of our local community, as both a local resident and Chair of Marsh Community Forum I urge you to please raise our concerns with Councillors and Nothing is mentioned about Fridays but Sunday at the relevant meetings of Kirklees Planning Committee,
