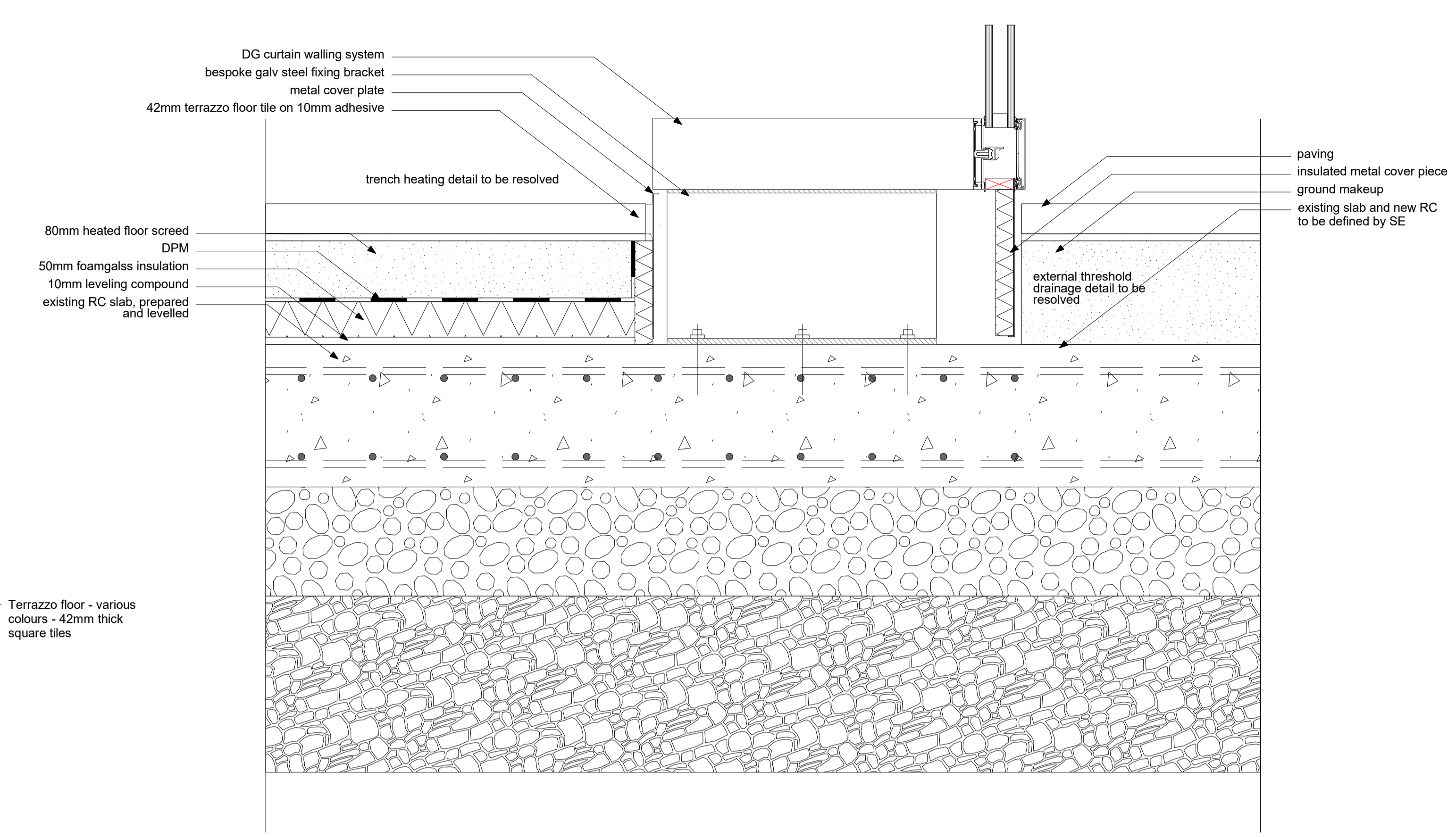


1 Food Hall Upper Ground Floor - showing terrazzo floor positions

Food Hall Floor Build-Up

The original market hall floor was lined with white and grey chip terrazzo tiles. The market stall floors were of timber and lined with olive coloured thermoplastic floor tiles.

The original market hall stalls were initially colour coded.

The base of the counters were formed by pieces of block board, at least some of which was Finnish Birch Blockboard, and all counter fronts or risers were to be finished with formica standard range laminates, in a range of nine different colours; - Marigold, Mustard, Silver Gleam, Stone Grey, Buffalo, Olive, Baltic Blue, Persian Blue Linette, Baltic Blue Linette.

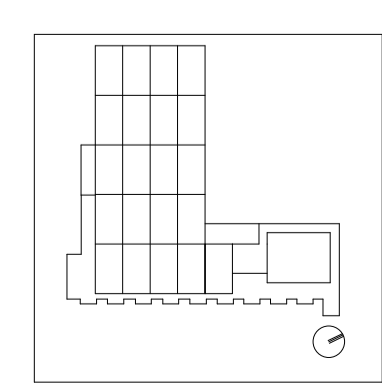
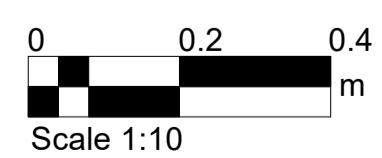
The colours were arranged so that no two adjacent blocks were given the same colours, and some colours were more commonly used than others. Unfortunately, surviving visible examples of the formica counter fronts are now very rare.

The counter fronts were to be coloured; for stalls 169 and 170, the counter front should be Persian Blue, for stalls 171 and 182 Mustard, for stalls 173 and 174 Baltic Blue, and for stalls 175 and 176 Olive.

In consideration of the original concept the proposals are for coloured terrazzo laid in blocks to reflect the layout of the market hall as it was. The tiles will be laid onto the insulated floating screed.
