The original application was made following Ofsted registration rules at the time, stipulating the maximum number of children of a certain age to be cared for and a maximum number in a care room. To satisfy demand then, we had a care room for 12 babies under 12 mths, another for 12 under 24mths and another for 26 over 24mths.

Many changes in the local demographics and government legislation have affected the nursery since, including the increase in duration of paid maternity leave, the opening of the local Surestart centre and subsequent closing, the increase in our responsibilities regarding safeguarding and social care adding further to our running costs, along with the reduction in demand for full day care and the uptake in part-time funded sessions only since the pandemic, at a rate which does not cover our costs to deliver, in real terms.

Over the last twenty years we have had to adapt and change to remain sustainable, while providing the valuable level of care and support we provide to families in the local community.

In 2012 Ofsted removed the stipulation to register the maximum number of children in a certain age group and per care room. Leaving it to the provision to decide the safe number within the EYFS Framework. Consequently, in 2013 we invested in the reconfiguration of our care rooms to provide more flexibility in our provision and to care for the larger proportion of over two year olds we had increasing demand for.

As the impact of the new NMW and utility bills tariff looms in April, we need to change again, to remain sustainable. We currently rent the Scout Hall for our After School Club, but some days we do not have enough children to justify the rent and the two staff required to keep children safe. Consequently, we would like our provision to be more flexible in the affordable care we offer, by increasing the maximum number of children we have on site and to use our Foundation Class Room in the nursery building on those days, when only a single member of staff would be required and we can't justify renting a large hall.

We currently have 17 car parking spaces, more than adequate for our current children numbers and more than provided by any other nursery of our size. We operate a 'Walking Bus' for our Out of School Club children and envisage minimum impact on neighbours.
