I have now received further feedback from WYCA regarding bus stop improvements/alterations required for the above site.

WYCA's view is that they do not see a significant benefit in relocating the bus stops on Barnsley Road, but do support upgrades to the existing stops 20680/20681 on Wakefield Road.

Therefore, for this development we would expect a S106 contribution of £33,000 to fund a new shelter and real-time at stop 20680 (eastbound stop) and new real-time display at stop 20681 (westbound stop).

The above is subject to adequate pedestrian facilities being made available to access these stops, and there being sufficient highway width to site the new shelter (min. 2m width required, so highway boundary checks will be required to see if the rear verge can be used to site the shelter). If this is not possible, then alternative options to improve public transport accessibility will need to be considered.

Please let me know if you are happy for me to send this email on to the highway consultants to inform the further assessment and design work, or if you wish to pass on via Acumen?
